Chew thoroughly before swallowing.

Do not exceed the recommended dosage.

4.4 Special warnings and precautions for use

- Sucrose 1,4 g. Patients with rare hereditary problems of fructose intolerance, glucosegalactose malabsorption or sucrase-isomaltase insufficiency should not take **Gummy** Vites Vitamin C.
- Glucose 240 mg. Patients with rare glucose-galactose malabsorption should not take
 Gummy Vites Vitamin C.
- Sucrose and glucose may be harmful to the teeth.
- o Less than 1 mmol sodium (23 mg) per gummy, that is to say essentially 'sodium-free'.
